Policy on Payment for Additional Modules

At Heriot-Watt University, the number of modules to be studied in order to achieve a final qualification are pre-determined. The full-time and part-time fees for all courses take account of the cost for all modules within a course that a student is required to study in order to achieve a final qualification.

Should a student wish to study module(s) in addition to those required to achieve the final qualification, the module fee(s) must be paid by the student.

Should a School or Institute require a student to study module(s) in addition to the standard modules for a course, the student will not be required to pay a fee for the additional module(s).

Where a student is required to repeat module(s) following unsuccessful re-assessment, the student will be required to pay the module(s) fee(s).
