Important Information for Candidates:

- 1) SR 1 = Seminar Room 1, Level 1, East Wing; SR 2 = Seminar Room 2, Level 1, East Wing; LS 1 = Learning Studio 1, Level 1, East Wing
- 2) Candidates are required to be present at the exam venue 15 minutes before the published time. You will not be permitted to enter the exam venue 30 minutes or more after the start of the exam.
