Important Information for Candidates :

- 1) **SR 3** = Seminar Room 3, Level 2, East Wing
 - 2) Candidates are required to be present at the exam venue 15 minutes before the published time. You will not be permitted to enter the exam venue 30 minutes or more after the start of the exam.
 - 3) Candidates are required to present either your Student ID or an alternative photographic ID to the invigilator for each examination.
 - 4) Please bring a jacket as the exam venue has centralised air-conditioning.
 - 5) No food or drink is permitted in the exam venue, with the exception of bottled water that should be in **a clear bottle no bigger than 500 ml**.
 - 6) **Mobile phones** must be switched off and kept in your bags before entering the exam venue.
 - 7) All **watches** need to be removed and kept in your bag before entering the exam venue.
 - 8) All materials must be bagged before entering the exam venue.
 - 9) It is advisable to bring your stationeries **in a clear pencil case** . Otherwise, the invigilators will be required to check your pencil cases during the examination.
 - 10) Where a calculator is required for the completion of the examination, candidates may use any **basic scientific calculator** , EXCEPT the following : graphics calculator, programmable calculator and a calculator which features text storage or retrieval facilities. (Please refer to the website for approved & non-approved list of calculators)
- Candidates must remember to bring their own calculator and ensure it is in good working order. The University will NOT supply spare calculators to any students.
- 11) Candidates shall not leave the exam venue during the FIRST hour and the LAST 30 minutes of the examination.(This includes toilet breaks).
