

# **Student Information**

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Using student enrolment headcounts, the student population is broken down as follows for on-campus students, excluding EBS MBA, pre-MBA and DBA students.

- Gender, Age, Ethnicity and Disability data is collected at all campuses.
- The additional protected characteristics of Religion or Belief, Sexual Orientation and Trans identity/history are not collected at the campuses in Dubai and Malaysia.

Throughout the report, headcounts numbers are rounded to the nearest 5, or indicated as less than 5 (<5) where applicable. As well as tables showing proportions by percentage, this edition of the report includes separate tables showing rounded headcounts for each characteristic category. Due to the nature of calculating totals from rounded headcounts using different levels of detail, small differences may be seen in some totals or different cuts of the data.

Where entrants are counted, they are defined by academic year of entry, not year of study, e.g. 2022-23 entrants include students admitted directly into year 2 or above of a programme in that academic year, as well as students admitted into year 1.

# 1. ENROLMENT HEADCOUNT BY CAMPUS & LEVEL (snapshots taken early in the calendar years 2023, 2024, 2025)

The number of students enrolled at the Dubai campus (Dub), Malaysia campus (Mal) and all Scottish campuses (Sco), by academic year and level of study (foundation, undergraduate (UG), postgraduate taught (PGT) and postgraduate research (PGR)). Numbers are rounded to the nearest 5 or indicated as less than 5 where applicable.

All "non-standard" students are included to the right of the table, with reasons for their exclusion from the "standard" population. Throughout this report, the "standard" population is used unless otherwise stated.

A small number of unknown values are excluded from the *% Female* and *% BME* calculations. *% BME* is defined here as all categories other than White, White – Scottish, White - other British, White – Irish, White – Polish, and Any other White background, where these options were available. *% Declaring a disability* is defined here using all affirmative declarations. Following current HESA reporting practices, it is assumed that the student has no disability if none is declared, therefore the full standard population is used here in the calculation.

Values are shown to the nearest percent, therefore a value of 100% should not be taken as literal.
