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HERIOT-WATT UNIVERSITY: PROFILE AT A GLANCE

Founded: 1821. Granted university status by Royal Charter in 1966.

Campus Locations: Edinburgh, Galashiels, Orkney, Dubai, Malaysia

The University's main Edinburgh campus comprises 380 acres of parkland and incorporates the Edinburgh Research Park established in 1971 as the first science park of its kind in the UK. In excess of 40 companies are currently based on the Research Park. The University's Scottish Borders Campus at Netherdale in Galashiels is home to the School of Textiles and Design. The Campus is shared with Scottish Borders College.

The University's International Centre for Island Technology based in Stromness, Orkney Islands (Orkney Campus), is part of the University's School of Life Sciences. The Centre concentrates on renewable energy, particularly marine energy.

In November 2011, Heriot-Watt University won a major international tender to establish a new purpose-built University Campus in Putrajaya, Malaysia. The Heriot-Watt Malaysia Campus will create opportunities for up to 4,000 undergraduate and postgraduate students to study degree-level programmes in science, business, engineering, mathematics and design. The Campus has been open since early 2013 offering a range of postgraduate programmes and the Undergraduate Foundation Programme. Substantial growth in undergraduate and postgraduate programmes has taken place since autumn 2014 when the new campus building formally opened.

More than one third of the University's 'on campus' students studying in Scotland are from outside of the UK making Heriot-Watt one of the most internationally diversified of any UK universities.

Transnational programmes (independent study in 144 countries worldwide or through a network of 46 Approved Learning Partners (ALPs). In HESA reporting year ending 31 July 2014 there were:

- 9,749 active matriculated ALP students
- 4,941 active matriculated independent (distance learning) students

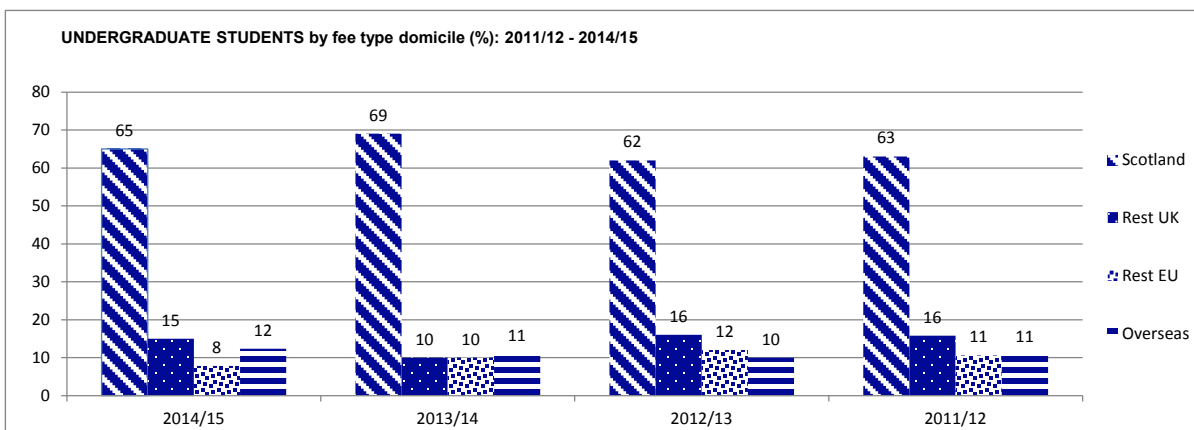

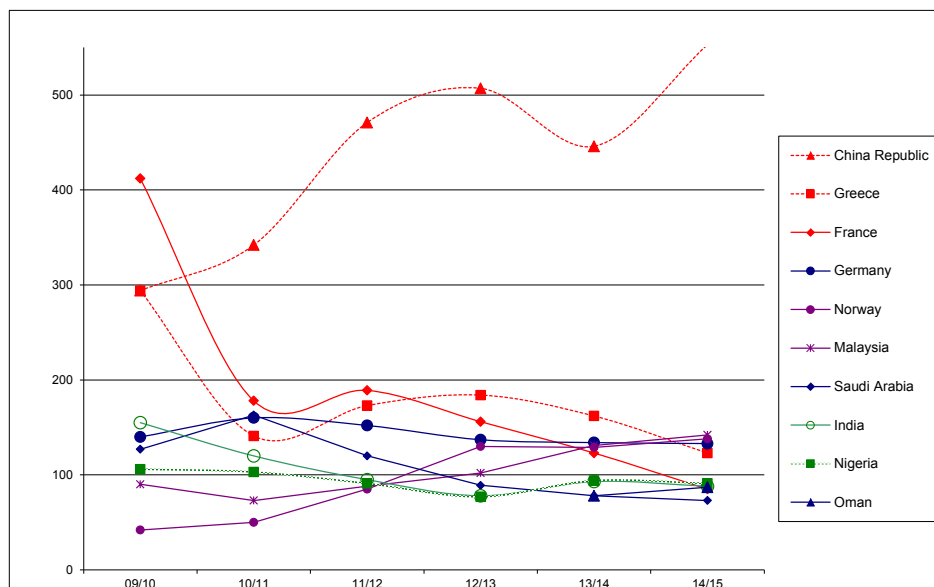

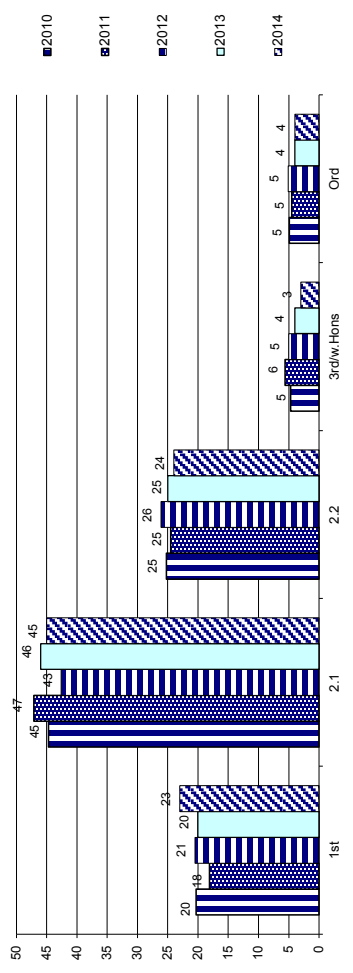
