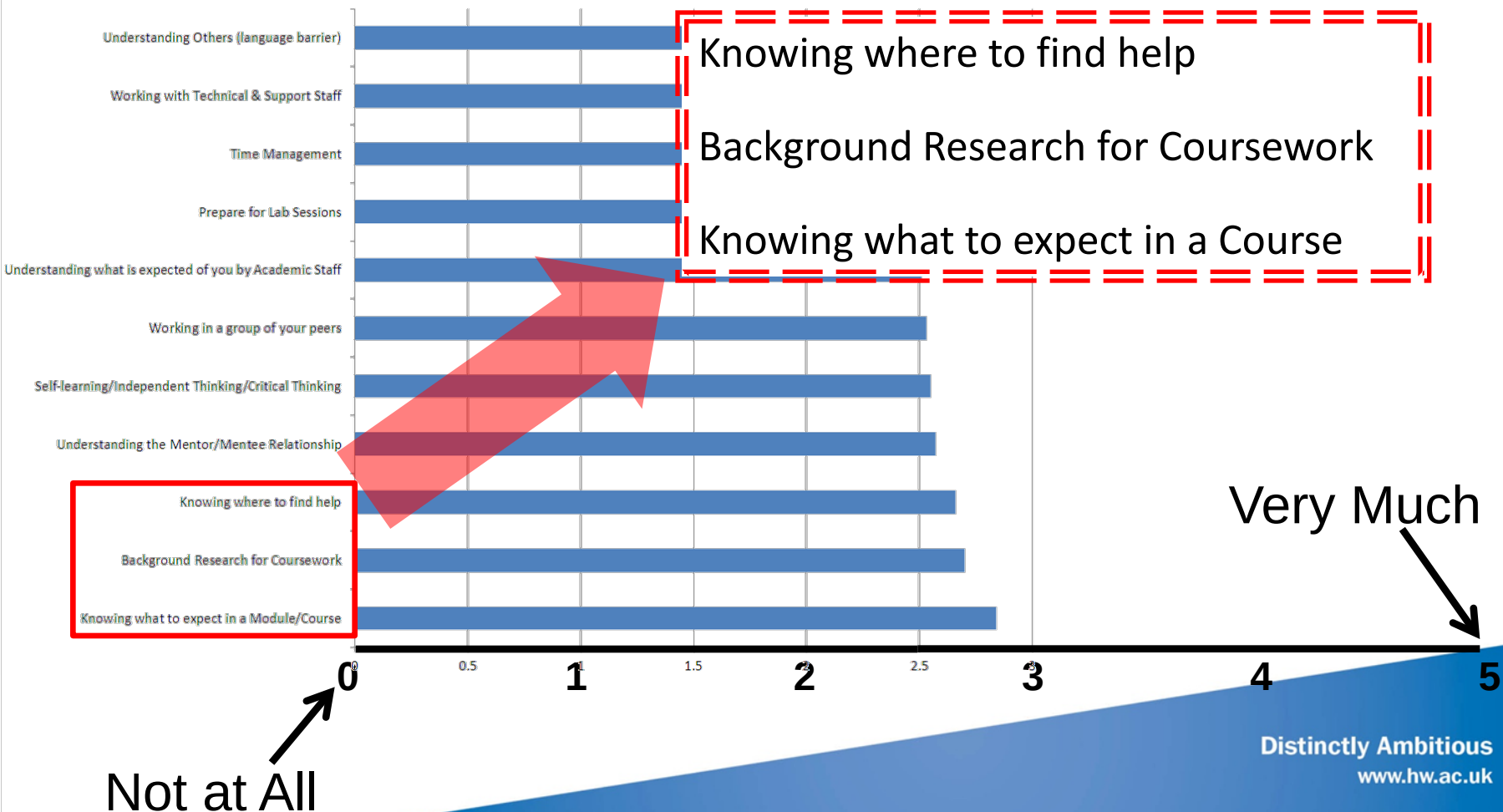

Concept: What is a “Virtual Tour”

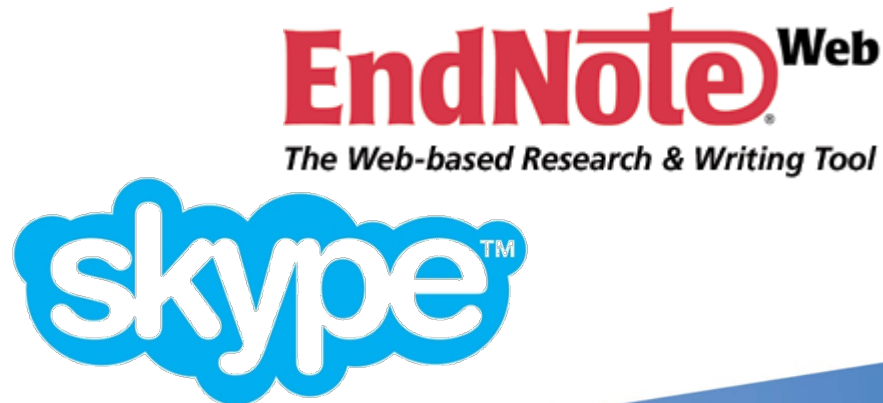
A virtual tour is a short podcast that is annotated with hyperlinks to guide the viewer (transitional student) to the information they need.
