 Nationality or degree from a UKVI-defined majority English-speaking country	 A degree taught in English at an overseas campus of a university based in a UKVI-listed country	 A valid English language test result from an approved provider (e.g. IELTS Academic, TOEFL iBT)
 Successfully completed a pre-session English programme (Heriot-Watt or other BALEAP-accredited UK university)	 Completed a UK university pre-master's qualification	 Achieved an approved school-level English qualification
