

Tuition fees at Heriot-Watt University

Students domiciled in England, Northern Ireland and Wales (plus the Isle of Man and the Channel Islands) who study in Scotland will pay a variable tuition fee.

For 2019 entry at Heriot-Watt, this will be £9,250 per year for a BA/BSc/MA Honours Degree. However, the total amount payable will be **capped for 3 years irrespective of the Honours Degree being completed over 3 or 4 years.**

(Fee levels are regulated by the UK Government and are subject to increase. Please also note that the annual fee still applies to the final additional year of the enhanced first degrees such as MEng/MChem/MMath/MPhys).

Heriot-Watt University Bursary

Available to all English, Northern Irish and Welsh domiciled students, our generous financial support is additional to any support offered by Student Finance England/Northern Ireland/Wales and is designed to support students from lower income backgrounds during their studies.

There are three levels of support depending on household income (as assessed by the relevant Student Finance agency):

Household Income	Award
Up to £25,000	£3,100 per year payment for living costs
£25,001 - £35,000	£2,100 per year payment for living costs
£35,001 - £42,600	£1,100 per year payment for living costs

Students do not need to apply for the Heriot-Watt University Bursary as these awards will be made automatically. Payment of contribution to living costs will be made in three instalments throughout the academic year.

Heriot-Watt Academic Scholarship

The Heriot-Watt Academic Scholarship seeks to encourage and reward talent and hard work. The Scholarship comprises: £1,000 bursary per year and is additional to any other bursaries.
