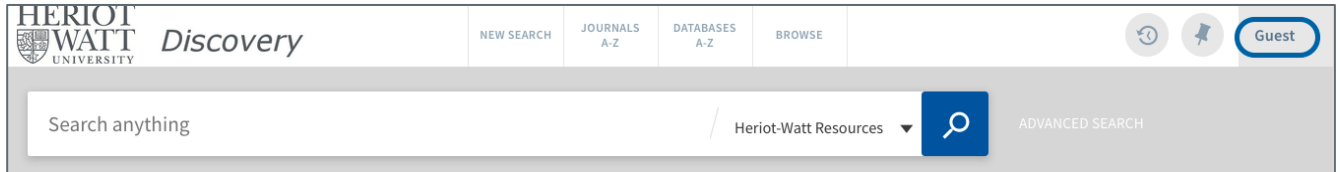


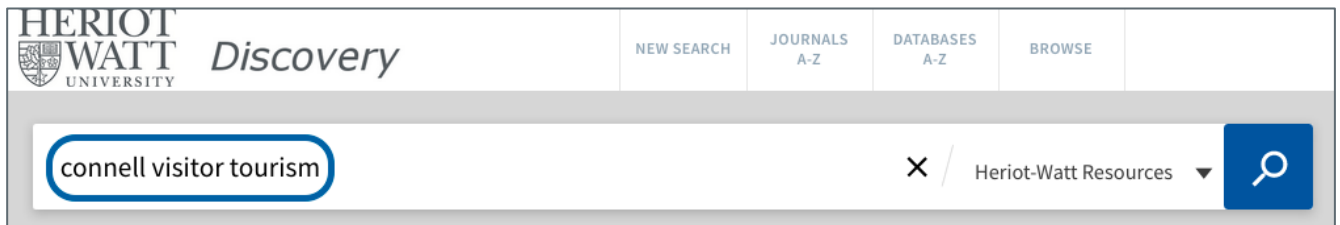
Finding a journal article

- 1 Go to Discovery at <https://discovery.hw.ac.uk/>
- 2 Sign in via the “Guest” link in the top right corner. You will get more search results if you sign in.

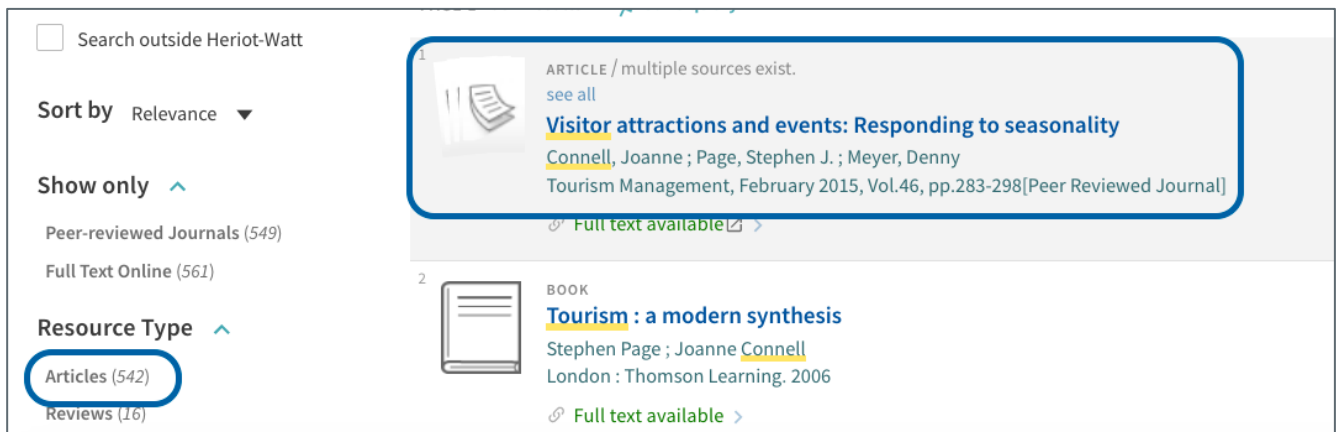


- 3 Type some words from the information about your article.

- 4 Click on the magnifying glass to search.
- 5 Find your article in the results list. If necessary, you could use the articles limiter from the left of the page to reduce the number of results.



6 Click on “Full Text Available”, and then click on the link to the article.
