Heriot-Watt University: Profile at a glance

Founded: 1821. Granted university status by Royal Charter in 1966.

Campus Locations: Edinburgh, Galashiels, Orkney, Dubai, Malaysia (from 2012)

The University's main Edinburgh campus comprises 380 acres of parkland and incorporates the Edinburgh Research Park established in 1971 as the first science park of its kind in the UK. In excess of 40 companies are currently based on the Research Park. In 2009, work was completed to co-locate with Scottish Borders College at the Netherdale Campus in Galashiels.

The Heriot-Watt University Dubai Campus was established in 2005 and accepted its first cohort of students in the autumn of that year. At the start of 2012/13 the student population had reached approximately 3,180.

The University's International Centre for Island Technology based in Stromness, Orkney Islands (Orkney Campus), is part of the University's Institute of Petroleum Engineering. The Centre concentrates on renewable energy, particularly marine energy.

In November 2011, Heriot-Watt University won a major international tender to establish a new purpose-built University Campus in Putrajaya, Malaysia. The Heriot-Watt Malaysia Campus will create opportunities for up to 4,000 undergraduate and postgraduate students to study degree-level programmes in science, business, engineering, mathematics and design. As at January 2013, the Campus had its first student intake which included 16 MBA students. Plans are progressing with a view to more degree courses being available from September 2014.

- 1,393 postgraduate taught course
- 648 postgraduate research

On-campus (Scottish Borders Campus)

- 587 undergraduate (including exchange and visiting students)

On-campus (Dubai)

- 2,181 undergraduate
- 1,000 postgraduate taught course

About one third of the University's 'on campus' students studying in Scotland are from outside of the UK making Heriot-Watt one of the most internationally diversified of any UK universities.

Transnational programmes (independent study in around 140 countries worldwide or through a network of 45 Approved Learning Partners ALPs). In HESA reporting year ending 31 July 2012 there were:

- 9,064 active matriculated ALP students
- 4,041 active matriculated independent (distance learning) students

Including all active students (registered or not yet registered for full degree programmes), the University had a population of more than 18,000 transnational programme students.

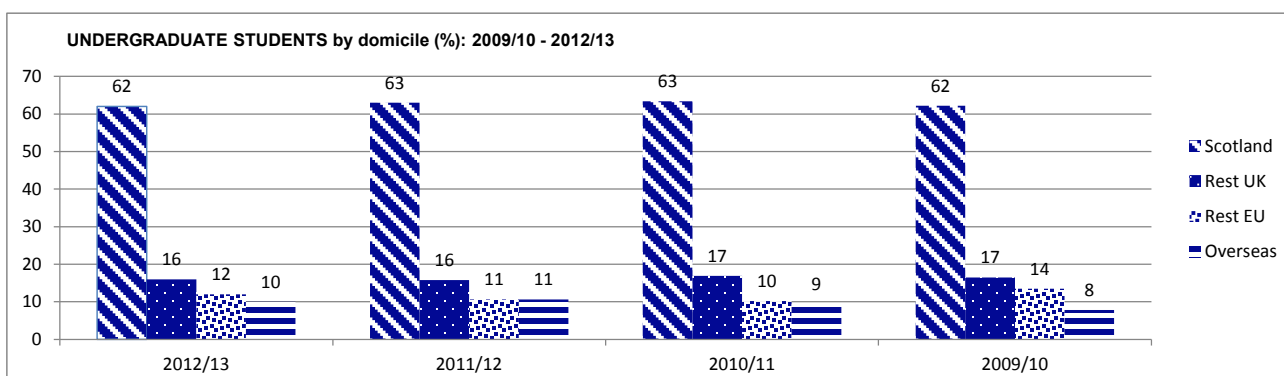

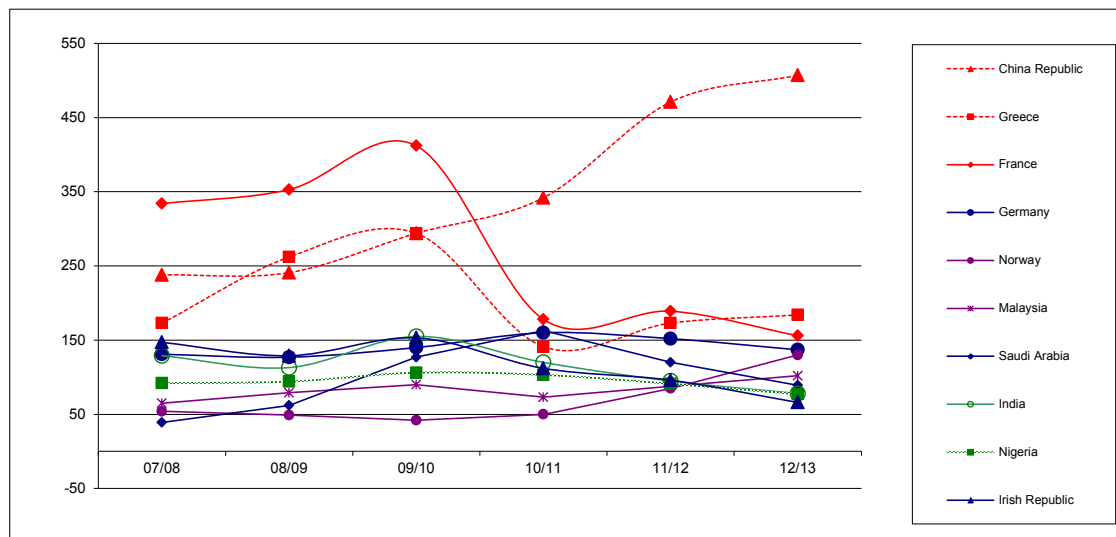
