'CHECK FOR FULL-TEXT'

On the results screen within **DISCOVERY** (or, e.g. in Google Scholar), you get the option to 'Check for Full Text' e.g.:

Whenever you see the 'Check for Full Text' link, click on it to see if Heriot-Watt provides access. You will be given one of the following options:

1. ARTICLE LINK (online)

Here, we have access to the article online. Click on the link that says 'Article' and this will take you directly to the article on the publisher website. You will usually get the option to view the article online, or as PDF. The second entry shows we also have access in print.

2. JOURNAL LINK (online)

Here, we have access to the article online. Click on the top 'Journal' link and this will take you to the journal page on the publisher website. As the link takes you to the journal page, and not the article page, you now have to search within the journal for the article that you are looking for. Do this by search for the "article title" in quote marks. This usually happens when the article is not yet published i.e. is ***In Press, Corrected Proof***. The second entry shows we also have access in print.

3. JOURNAL LINK (print)
