Joining Instructions:

- Click on the purple **Browse memberships** button
- On the **Subscriptions** page, select the third membership option down in the left column **Company Sponsored Member** – (it's important you select the correct membership or you will be prompted to make a payment).

Please ensure you enter your University in the **Employer** field and if you are a staff member, your job title in the **Personal Profile** box so that your membership can be validated. **N.B. Please complete this field for your University whether you are staff or a student* or you may be charged for your membership!**
