I am pleased to announce the introduction of a new student award for academic excellence - the Deputy Principal's Award.

Criteria

In 2017/18 the Award will be made to individual students who meet the following criteria:

- Full time undergraduate students* studying on campus at any one of our campus locations.
- Attain 6 Grade A's with passes at Grade D or higher in the other courses, at the first sitting.
- Students with any reassessments, course failures, or grade Es in the year are automatically disgualified from the award.

The Award

Any student meeting the criteria will receive a letter from the Deputy Principal (Learning and Teaching) advising them of the award.
